Having considered the letter of the Institute of Genetics and Cytology, NAS of Belarus, of April 18, 2018 No. 271-08/359, the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environmental Protection of the Republic of Belarus confirms that the transfer of the genetic material (tubers) of Belarusian diploid potato lines (IGC 09/8.24; IGC 12/45.12; IGC 12/42.1; IGC 12/42.3; IGC 08/29.39) developed at the Institute of Genetics and Cytology, NAS of Belarus, for the involvement of wild potato species in breeding to the Federal State Budgetary Scientific Institution “K.A.
