- 3.3. Any changes to the Agreement procedure and the use of genetic resources referred to in Paragraph 2 should be in the form of side agreements (protocols) to this Agreement.
- 3.4. The user of genetic resources must obtain the prior approval of the national competent authority for:
 - submitting an application to acquire an intellectual property right to an invention based on the genetic resources accessed
 - commercial use of genetic resources accessed
