Type of use allowed by the permit or its equivalent

Non-Commercial

Specific uses covered by the permit or its equivalent or use restrictions:

The genetic resources transferred in accordance with the Agreement should be used exclusively for scientific research for non-commercial purposes.

The Parties to the Agreement shall have equal rights to the results of scientific research and their publication. The transfer of genetic resources by the Provider of Genetic Resources shall be subject to the Provisions of the Nagoya Protocol on Access to Genetic Resources and the Fair and Equitable Sharing of Benefits Arising from their Utilization to the Convention on Biological Diversity.

The use of transferred genetic resources, as well as derived genetic resources (lines, varieties) resulting from the utilization (involvement) of the genetic resources of the Provider of Genetic Resources in breeding for commercial purposes shall be possible only after the conclusion of a new agreement on sharing of benefits obtained as a result of their commercialization.

Any changes in terms of the genetic resources' utilization should be formalized in the form of additional agreements (Protocols) to the Agreement.

Conditions for third party transfer:

The User of Genetic Resources should obtain prior approval from the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environmental Protection of the Republic of Belarus (the Competent National Authority) for:

- submitting of an application for intellectual property rights to the invention based on accessed genetic resources;
- commercial use of accessed genetic resources.
